

## Articulation Agreement between Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College Human Services Programs and The College of St. Scholastica Social Work Program

In order to facilitate the transferability of Fond du Lac Tribal Community College (FDLTCC) students who complete an Associate of Arts Degree with the Minnesota Transfer Agreement (MTA) Curriculum and an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) Degree from one of the Human Service Program options to The College of St. Scholastica Social Work Program, the two institutions agree beginning Fall Semester 1999 to allow transfer of the following courses, as meeting the criteria for course work falling within the program requirements of the social work major:
