

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN LAKE SUPERIOR COLLEGE AND THE UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-SUPERIOR

In order to facilitate the transferability of students who have completed the Accounting Associate of Applied Science Degree at LSC to UW-S, the faculty of the institutions, effective January 1, 1995, agree to allow the transfer of:

- up to 21 semester hours in general education courses
- up to 36 semester hours in the following required lower-level courses
- up to 6 business general elective credits

for a total of no more than 63 semester credits, leading to a comprehensive major within the Department of Business and Economics. Credits will be granted only to students who complete a bachelor's degree at UW-Superior in the given major and/or the given cluster.

Transferability of specific general education courses is contingent upon the receipt of the associate degree. Transferability of major-specific courses in this agreement is also dependent upon the receipt of the associate degree of applied science. Transferability is contingent upon completion of LSC courses with a grade of C or better.

It is understood that the transferability of credits as put forth within the articulation agreement is advisory. Students who matriculate to UW-S are subject to the degree requirements in effect in the students' catalog of entry at UW-S.
