

**TRANSFER AGREEMENT

Metropolitan State University, College of Management will accept students in transfer in the **Industrial Management Bachelor of Applied Science** degree from Dakota County Technical College. Students who have completed the Associate of Applied Science degree from Dakota County Technical College in the following programs will be eligible for transfer into this Metropolitan State University program:

Automotive Service Educational Program	Heavy Duty Truck Technology
Biomedical Equipment Technology	Nanoscience Technology
Body Service Educational Program	Telecommunications

Electrical Construction & Maintenance	Interior Design

The transfer of credits from the Associate of Applied Science degree programs to the Industrial Management Bachelor of Applied Science degree will be accepted in the following manner:

- 40 credits from the technical area in a “block” rather than course by course equivalency.
- General education courses which are part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum.
- Courses which are required in the major in the College of Business (Macro-Economics, Micro-Economics, Statistics, College Algebra) must be evaluated prior to transfer.
