Admission Requirements

- Must have completed an AAS degree in Culinary Arts
- GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Completion of an approved degree plan for the BAS degree

Curriculum Requirements - 124 credits

I General Education and Liberal Studies 48 credits

A. General Education

1. Communications: Two writing courses (minimum of intermediate writing) and one oral/visual communications course.
2. Math: One course at the College Algebra level or higher is required.
3. Natural and Physical Sciences: One course.
4. Social/Behavioral Sciences: Two courses from two different disciplines, i.e., Economics, Sociology, and Anthropology. Microeconomics is required.
5. Humanities: Two courses from two different disciplines, i.e., History, Literature, Philosophy and Religion.
6. Electives: Remaining credits to reach 40 from any of the above disciplines. A computer literacy course and Statistics must be among the electives.

B. Liberal Studies: Upper Division - Metropolitan State University 8 credits

Note: One course from global studies and one course from cultural diversity are required. These courses may be taken from the General Education menu.
