Metropolitan State University, College of Management will accept students in transfer in the **Industrial Management Bachelor of Applied Science** degree from South Central Technical College. Students who have completed the Associate of Applied Science degree from South Central Technical College in the following programs will be eligible for transfer into the Metropolitan State University program:

Architectural Drafting  
Auto Body and Collision Technology  
Automotive Service  
Carpentry-Cabinetmaking  
Computer Integrated Machining  
Electronics for Manufacturing Technologies  
Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration  
Outdoor Power and Marine  
Wireless Communications Electronic Technician

The transfer of credits from the Associate of Applied Science degree programs to the Industrial Management Bachelor of Applied Science degree will be accepted in the following manner:

- 40 credits from the technical area in a “block” rather than course by course equivalency.
- General education courses which are part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum.
- Courses which are required in the major in the College of Business (Macro-Economics, Micro-Economics, Statistics, College Algebra) must be evaluated prior to transfer.
