2. The North Hennepin Community College course section numbers are listed as quarter/(semester), where semester numbers have been determined at this time.
3. Elective courses taken at North Hennepin Community College will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by The College of Visual Arts to determine how they may apply to the degree at the College of Visual Arts.
4. Courses at North Hennepin Community College which have been completed with a grade of "C" are acceptable to meet program requirements at College of Visual Arts, unless the College of Visual Arts requires a higher acceptable grade.
5. Assessment in reading, English, and math may be required for students transferring to the College of Visual Arts. Assessment scores will determine placement into any necessary writing, mathematics, and critical thinking courses.
6. If courses have been substituted for those specified in the program at North Hennepin Community College, they will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis by College of Visual Arts.
7. Studio courses accepted by the College of Visual Arts from North Hennepin Community College are contingent upon a portfolio review by the College of Visual Arts faculty.
8. A student may transfer a maximum of 66 semester credits into a degree program at the College of Visual Arts.
