Cooperative Agreement Regarding the Business Administration Programs

This agreement has been entered into by Anoka Ramsey Community College and Metropolitan State University for the benefit of students and prospective students at the two institutions. The purpose of the agreement is to insure programs of high academic quality, to encourage student achievement, and to facilitate the transfer of course credits and a smooth transition from one related degree program to the other.

Joint Admission

Students may be jointly admitted to both institutions. With joint admissions, students are guaranteed a place in Metropolitan State University's Business Administration program upon transfer from Anoka Ramsey Community College. Joint admissions also provide that students:

1. can concurrently enroll in courses at both institutions;
2. can apply appropriate lower division credits, including those awarded through competence Based Education, with a grade of better than D (or the equivalent), toward metropolitan state University degree requirements, up to a limit of 99 quarter credits;
3. will have access to program advisors at both institutions;
4. will have any other rights and privileges of students at both institutions and will be sent mailings from both institutions.

Program Articulation

1. Business courses offered at Anoka Ramsey community college and their relationship to Metro State requirements are listed in Attachment A.
2. Students with an Associate of Arts degree from Anoka Ramsey Community college will have fully met all general education requirements at Metropolitan State University.
3. For students without an Associate of Arts degree, community *college* courses will be accepted toward meeting Metropolitan State University general education requirements consistent with written equivalency guides.
