# *Transferring into the Social Work Program*

Generally students need to refer to the Bemidji State University catalog for policy and procedures for transferring to the BSU Social Work program. The Bemidji State University Admissions Office determines what liberal education courses may be transferred in if a student has not earned an A.A. degree from a community college. The following required courses in the Social Work Major may be transferred from another educational institution:

- Introduction to Psychology
- Contemporary Social Problems
- General Biology: Evolution and Ecology
- Abnormal Psychology
- Introduction to American Politics

The following additional courses may be considered for transfer after course materials-syllabus, course outline, readings and text are reviewed by a Social Work faculty member and the program director. These course are:

- Ethnic and Minority Group Relations
- Intercultural Communications
- Interpersonal Relations
- Social Statistics
- Methods of Social Research

Other required courses in the Social Work major may be considered for transfer if the student was enrolled in the courses at a Council on Social Work Education accredited program.
