

Articulation Agreement between Mesabi Range Community and Technical College Human Services Programs and the College of St. Scholastica Social Work Program.

In order to facilitate the transferability of Mesabi Range Community and Technical College students who complete an Associate of Arts Degree with the Minnesota Transfer Agreement (MTA) Curriculum from one of the Human Service Program options to The College of St. Scholastica Social Work Program, the two institutions agree beginning Fall Semester 1999 to allow transfer of the following courses, as meeting the criteria for course work falling within the program requirements of the social work major:

It is understood that the transferability of credits as put forth within the Articulation Agreement is advisory. Students who matriculate to CSS are subject to the degree requirements in effect at the time of transfer at CSS and to the Social Work- Program admission process.
