## Articulation Agreement Between Mesabi Range Community and Technical College Human Services Program And The University of Wisconsin-Superior Social Work Program

In order to facilitate the transferability of Mesabi Range Community and Technical College (MRCTC) students who have completed an Associate of Arts Degree in Human Services to the University of Wisconsin-Superior (UW-S) and its Social Work Program, the two institutions agree, effective Fall Semester, 2000, to allow the transfer of the following courses, as meeting the criteria of course work falling within the program requirements of the social work major:

HSER 1231, Introduction to Human Services

Will be accepted within the major in lieu of SW 121, Introduction to Social Work; the transfer course must be taught by and MSW AND/OR contain documentable content on the generalist perspective, the development of social welfare and social work as a profession, and the history of social welfare.

HSER 1233, Interviewing

Will be accepted within the major in lieu of SW 227, Interpersonal Skills; the transfer course Must have been taught by an MSW AND/OR Contain documentable content on the generalist Perspective and the ecological model of practice.

Will be allowed with the major in lieu of the UW-S introductory sociology course

Will be allowed with the major in lieu of the UW-S human biology course
