

## Articulation Agreement

Between

### **Normandale Community College and Bemidji State University**

#### Statement of Purpose

This agreement is between Bemidji State University and Normandale Community College. The Purpose of this agreement is to facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related degree program to another.

Students must complete the Associate of Arts degree or the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum to be eligible for admission into the DLiTE program. The 16-credit Education Career Opportunities certificate may be part of their electives at Normandale Community College. Students who complete the AA or the Transfer Curriculum and achieve a grade point average of 2.5 or better at Normandale Community College will receive the following:

1. Admission to the DLiTE program at Bemidji State University as long as students apply at least one semester prior to desired semester for enrollment, and if space is available.
2. Acceptance by Bemidji State University of }ALL 64 credits in the AA degree, providing no developmental courses are included as part of the 64 credits.

Students who do not have an AA degree will submit their transcripts for a course-by-course evaluation following guidelines for the Minnesota General Education Transfer Curriculum. ECO courses may transfer into the BSU degree program as general electives, pending review by Bemidji State University.

#### Terms and Conditions of Credit Transfer:

The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits shall be in full compliance with MnSCU policies and all other state and Federal education policies pertaining to undergraduate credit transfer. Current students and graduates, who have earned degrees, certificates or diplomas from Normandale Community College, shall be eligible for credit evaluation under the terms of this agreement.

Representatives of both institutions will review the program and student progress annually.

#### Collaboration Practices

Both institutions will inform potential students about this program.

#### Articulation Implementation and Agreement Review

The Academic Dean at Bemidji State University and the Vice President of Academic Affairs and Student Affairs at Normandale Community College will be responsible for implementing this articulation agreement. Each instructor will conduct outcomes assessment, and the Dean and Vice President will teleconference regularly to review the agreements.

This agreement becomes effective upon the date it is signed and remains in effect until June 1, 2004, unless terminated or amended by either party with prior written notice.
