

AGREEMENT

Northland College and Minnesota State Colleges and Universities
September 2004 – September 2005

Northland College offers junior year status to students from the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities who have completed the Associate in Arts (A.A.) and Associate in Science (A.S.) degree and who are admitted by Northland College.

- Junior year standing means the equivalent of at least 58 credit hours have been successfully completed. (Minnesota State Colleges and Universities who are included in this agreement are listed in Attachment A.)
- Up to 65 semester hours of A.A. and A.S. Degree transfer credit from Minnesota State Colleges and Universities will be applied toward the Northland College degree. Total hours of credit needed to graduate are 124. A minimum of twenty out of the final thirty credits need to be earned at Northland.
- Satisfaction of the requirements for the Associate in Arts degree will serve as completion of the Northland College liberal education program. The Associate of Science degree may require additional courses in the liberal arts for graduation.
- All college level work undertaken at Minnesota State Colleges and Universities, and successfully completed with a grade of C- or better will become part of the student's permanent record at Northland College.
- Official transcripts of such work must be presented at the time of application for admission.
- Grades from transfer courses will not be recorded on the transcript or included in the Northland College grade point average.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Northland College recognizes the achievement of its incoming students. MnSCU students who have completed their Associate's degree and plan on enrolling full-time at Northland College will be awarded the following scholarship:
