

# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

## ROCHESTER COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE and UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA

RCTC: Associate in Applied Science Degree Health Programs  
U of M: UMC Bachelor of Applied Health

This agreement is entered into by Rochester Community and Technical College (RCTC) and the University of Minnesota, Crookston, Bachelor of Applied Health Program, in order to:

1. ensure appropriate, high-quality preparation of students for careers in Health Services, and
2. ensure successful transfer of lower division credits into baccalaureate programs.

This agreement provides a core curriculum to be offered by Rochester Community and Technical College, that can be transferred to the Bachelor of Applied Health Program, University of Minnesota, Crookston. Rochester Community and Technical College Health Sciences courses will be accepted as comparable courses in meeting requirements of the receiving institution's Bachelor of Applied Health Program. The general education required for this articulated degree meets some of the 8-10 areas specified in the MNTC.

Rochester Community and Technical College's AAS Health Sciences Degree Programs are made up of 30 transfer level general education credits and 48 occupation related credits. The programs are designed for possible employment at the associate degree level and/or for transfer to a baccalaureate program, the Bachelor of Applied Health Program.

**Duration of agreement:** This agreement shall become effective on the day signing is completed and shall remain in effect until terminated by either party. It shall be reviewed periodically by the Rochester Community and Technical College representatives and representatives of the University of Minnesota, Crookston, Bachelor of Applied Health Program. These representatives shall have responsibility for monitoring student success and the effectiveness of the agreement in meeting the needs of students.
