

**Articulation Agreement**

Receiving Program: Bachelor of Science in Business

**PART I: TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT**

**Statement of Purpose:**

This agreement has been entered into by Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College and St. Cloud State University. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related degree program to another. The attached appendices shall describe the required program of study at Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College for admission eligibility to St. Cloud State University in the Bachelor of Science in Business and the course of study required at St. Cloud State University to complete the degree. This agreement identifies all required and equivalent courses at each institution.

**Terms and Conditions of Credit Transfer:**

The parties of this agreement hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth in this document.

The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits shall be in full compliance with MnSCU policies and all other state and Federal education policies pertaining to undergraduate credit transfer. Current students and graduates who have earned degrees, certificates or diplomas from Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College shall be eligible for credit evaluation under the terms of this agreement. Program specific requirements and/or required courses are listed in the appendices of this agreement.

Transfer students will be accorded the same standards and criteria for admission to a major program as students who originated their education at St. Cloud State University.

Associate of Arts degree transfer students and others who have completed the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum are exempt from additional lower division general education courses unless the degree program requires specific lower division general education courses.

Applicants accepted must fulfill the graduation requirements of the degree granting institution.

**Joint Admission:**

Students who are eligible may concurrently enroll in courses at both institutions and if concurrently enrolled may have access to advising and other services at both institutions.

**Collaboration Practices:**

Tuition and fees will be paid to the institution from which the student takes a course.

Upon student request, each institution will forward to the other copies of transcripts from students in the program.

Both institutions will inform potential students about this program.


**PART II: IMPLEMENTATION AND REVIEW**

The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the collaborating institutions shall be responsible for implementing this agreement, for identifying and incorporating any changes in subsequent agreements, and for conducting a periodic review of this agreement.

This agreement becomes effective upon signature by both parties, and remains in effect until terminated or amended by either party through written notice to the other party.

Lower division Business courses can be taken as part of the 12 credit requirement.
