

**Articulation Agreement between Aviation Bachelor of Science Degree and
Pre-Airway Science Associate of Arts Degree**

Sending Institution: **Anoka Ramsey Community College, Cambridge, MN**

And

Receiving Institution: **St. Cloud State University, St. Cloud, MN**

Statement of Purpose:

This agreement has been entered into by **St. Cloud State University and Cambridge Campus of Anoka Ramsey Community College**. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related degree program to another. It is further recognized that the attached appendix(s) shall describe the required program of study at the **Cambridge Campus of Anoka Ramsey Community College** for admission eligibility to **St. Cloud State University, in the Bachelor of Science in Aviation program**. This agreement identifies all required and equivalent courses at each institution.

Terms and Conditions of Credit Transfer:

The parties of this agreement hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth herein.

The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits shall be in full compliance with MnSCU policies and all other state and Federal education policies pertaining to undergraduate credit transfer. Current students and graduates, who have earned degrees, certificates or diplomas from Anoka Ramsey Community College, shall be eligible for credit evaluation under the terms of this agreement. Program specific requirements and/or required courses are listed and defined in Appendix A of this agreement.

Transfer students will be accorded the same standards and criteria for admission to a major degree sequence as native St. Cloud State University students.

- **Associate of Arts degree** transfer students who have completed the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum are exempt from additional lower-division general education courses unless the degree requires program specific lower division and general education courses.

Applicants accepted must fulfill the graduation requirements of the degree granting institution identified in Appendix A.

Joint Admission

Students may:

- Concurrently enroll in courses at both institutions.
- Have access to advising and other services at both institutions.

Collaboration Practices

- Tuition and fees will be paid to the institution from which the student takes a course as specified in Appendix A.
- Upon student request, each institution will forward to the other, copies of transcripts from students in the program.
- Both institutions will inform potential students about this program.

Articulation Implementation and Agreement Review

The Chief Academic Officer or designee of the collaborating institutions, shall be responsible for implementing this agreement, for identifying the incorporating any changes in subsequent agreements, and for conducting a periodic review of this agreement.

This agreement becomes effective on July 1, 2000, and remains in effect until terminated or amended by either party.

Memorandum of Cooperation Between **Anoka Ramsey Community College** and **St. Cloud State University**.

Transfer Articulation Agreement for Aviation Bachelor of Science Degree.

This agreement includes specific requirements for admission into a program, outlines requirements, and indicates which courses can be used to meet program prerequisites as well as general education, major and program, and graduation requirements.

Admissions Requirements:

Students must meet all admission requirements at Anoka Ramsey Community College in place at the time this agreement goes into effect and, upon transfer to St. Cloud State University, must meet SCSU admission requirements.

Graduation Requirements:

Students who satisfactorily complete the AA degree program outlined below will need to complete two years and 64 additional credits in accordance with SCSU requirements in order to complete the Bachelor of Science degree in Aviation.
