3. Courses which have been completed with a grade of D are acceptable to meet program requirements unless the UW-Stout major requires a higher acceptable grade.
4. The maximum number of transferable credits is 72.
5. The attached program plan sheet reflects the requirements in the Vocational Rehabilitation program which pertains to this agreement.
6. In completing a degree in Vocational Rehabilitation at UW-Stout, students transferring from St. Cloud Technical College will have to complete the following requirements:

7. This articulation agreement applies only to the B.S. in Vocational Rehabilitation in effect Fall 1998 until revised. A change of major invalidates these course/credits for transfer unless they are approved within some other program-to-program articulation agreement for a different major at UW-Stout.
