

**Articulation Agreement between
North Hennepin Community College
and Winona State University**

Sending program: Associate of Fine Arts--Studio Art

Receiving Program: Bachelor of Arts in Art (Studio Arts Option)

PART I: TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT

Statement of Purpose:

This agreement has been entered into by North Hennepin Community College and Winona State University. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related degree program to another. The attached appendices shall describe the required program of study at North Hennepin for admission eligibility to Winona State University in the Bachelor of Arts in Art and the course of study required at Winona State University to complete the degrees. This agreement identifies the required and equivalent courses at North Hennepin.

Terms and Conditions of Credit Transfer:

The parties of this agreement hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth in this document.

The evaluation and transfer of earned college credits shall be in full compliance with MnSCU policies and all other state and federal education policies pertaining to undergraduate credit transfer. Current students and graduates who have earned appropriate degrees, certificates or diplomas from North Hennepin Community College shall be eligible for credit evaluation under the terms of this agreement.

Transfer students will be accorded the same standards and criteria for admission to a major program as students who originated their education at Winona State University. Associate of Fine Arts degree students who have completed the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum are exempt from additional lower division general education courses.

Applicants accepted must fulfill the graduation requirements of the degree-granting institution. B.A. Art (Studio Arts Option) students must earn a minimum grade of "C" in each studio art course and have a GPA of 2.50 in all studio and art history courses and a 2.50 overall GPA. In addition, the applicant must maintain a 2.75 GPA in all art education, studio and art history courses.

Joint Admission:

Students who are eligible may concurrently enroll in courses at both institutions and, if concurrently enrolled, may have access to advising and other services at both institutions.

Collaboration Practices:

Tuition and fees will be paid to the institution from which the student takes a course.

Upon student request, each institution will forward to the other, copies of transcripts from students in the program.

Both institutions will inform potential students about this program.

PART II: IMPLEMENTATION AND REVIEW

The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the collaborating institutions shall be responsible for implementing this agreement, for identifying and incorporating any changes in subsequent agreements, and for conducting a periodic review of this agreement.

This agreement becomes effective on June 1, 2005, and remains in effect until terminated or amended by either party by written notice to the other party.
