ON CAMPUS

- BSU faculty and staff are in their 2nd year of using the newly renovated Bridgeman Hall, containing our Design Technology program, Industrial Technology program and the 3d technology.
- **360°**, a partnership of Minnesota colleges and universities led by Bemidji State University which has been assembled to promote careers in manufacturing and applied engineering, announces the launch of its web site, www.360mn.org.
- Funding was received to re-model Sattgast Hall, the Science facility
- The remodeling in Linden Hall, a residence hall is continuing, which will be converted into suites to fit the needs and expectations of today's students. This is expected to be completed Fall 2008.
- Nearly 80 percent of the campus will have wireless capabilities
- The 2007 enrollment number, 4792, is the largest at BSU in four years and also is the fourth-highest headcount in a decade.
- BSU is on the cutting edge of technology with the nation's first one-platform student computer lab. All of the SuperLab computers were replaced with Apple's new Intel based iMac computers which run both the Mac and Windows operating systems.
- BSU has opened a Veterans Resource Center to serve veterans who are attending or plan on attending the university.
- Residential Life has guaranteed double rooms as singles again for transfer students for 2007-08.

RECOGNITION

- The Minnesota State Colleges and Universities named the Bemidji State University bachelor of fine arts in creative and professional writing as a recipient of an Excellence in Curriculum Programming Award. The major is the only such bachelor's degree offered in Minnesota and one of only 13 programs in the United States.
- Bemidji State University was named a "Green Power Partner" by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for its commitment to purchase renewable energy
