**Enrollment Update**

Approximately 7400 students attended MSUM this past fall. Of this total, 1090 were new freshman, and 675 were new transfer students.

**Admission**

Transfer students need to have a minimum GPA of at least a 2.0, and 24 graded credits, for **automatic** admission into MSUM as a transfer student. Students whose GPA is below a 2.0 will be required to submit an **appeal** for admission into the University. An admissions committee will review the student's appeal file for consideration of admission on probation. Transfer students who have less than 24 credits completed will need to be able to meet freshman admissions criteria in order to be admitted.

**Application Deadlines**

Priority deadline for spring semester 2008 is November 1<sup>st</sup>.  
Priority deadline for fall semester 2008 is April 1<sup>st</sup>.  
Students who apply by these dates will be eligible to secure classes at the early registration programs. Our final deadline to apply for admission is December 1<sup>st</sup> for spring semester, and August 1<sup>st</sup> for fall semester.

**New Dragon Core General Education Requirement begins for transfer students Fall 2007**

MSUM has redesigned the Liberal Studies requirement for transfer students beginning Fall Semester 2007. The new Dragon Core with 11 categories of courses is similar to the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum. Transfer students who have completed their MnTC, or Associate of Arts Degree will be waived of the Dragon Core just as they were waived of the previous Liberal Studies requirement

## Dragon Transfer Scholarships

Transfer students who have a GPA of 3.5, or higher, and who will have completed at least 24 graded credits by the end of their academic study prior to enrolling at MSUM, may apply for an academic transfer scholarship. The awards for the academic transfer scholarship range between \$500-\$1000 dollars. The deadline to apply for the academic transfer scholarship award is June 30<sup>th</sup>.

**New!!** This past year we added 5 \$1000 dollar Phi Theta Kappa scholarship awards for members of this honorary society who transfer into MSUM. As of 4/2007 more money added for transfer students. Approx. \$45,000 available.
