Admissions

Application Deadline

- Fall Semester—June 15
- Spring Semester—November 15
- Summer Semester—March 15

Admissions Eligibility

- Transfer: Students with 16 or more semester credits and 2.0 or higher GPA are admitted as transfer students

- Freshmen: Admitted on basis of high school rank of 50th percentile or higher, or ACT/SAT of median score or above, or GED
