Transfer Scholarships:

- Southwest awards over \$10,000 per year to transfer students.
- Awards are made on the following criteria:
 - Date of Application received
 - AA Degree/ MTC + 2.5+ GPA = \$500 for 2 years
 - AA Degree/ MTC + 3.0+ GPA = \$750 for 2 years
 - AA Degree/ MTC + 3.8+ GPA = \$1000 for 2 years

Scholarship application deadline is June 1st
