#### Basic Guidelines

***It is recommended that students transfer to MCAD after one full year of college.***

Liberal Arts classes that are comparable to those taught at MCAD will be considered for transfer, including most art history, humanities, language\*\* and social science courses. We **do not** accept math, natural science, musical or theatrical performance classes, physical education or business (accounting, math, etc) classes. Course content is always considered when determining the transfer of credit and a course description may be required in order to determine transfer eligibility. A maximum of 39 Liberal Art courses may be transferred if requirements are met.

Studio classes require a portfolio of additional work for each course in order to transfer studio credit. In other words, if the student intends to transfer three studio courses, three separate portfolios would need to be submitted. **A course syllabus is required when submitting the portfolios for transfer.** For specific information about what is required in the student's particular situation, please contact a Transfer Specialist in the Admissions Office. The student should not submit a transfer portfolio without clear guidelines from a Transfer Specialist. A maximum of 36 Studio Art courses may be transferred if requirements are met.

Credit will transfer only for classes with a straight "C" or better. Grades lower than a "C" (including C-) will not be eligible for transfer. The A.A. and MnTC are NOT accepted and will be reviewed course-by-course.

An applicant must be fully admitted to MCAD before transfer credit will be evaluated.

Students entering Fall semester must be admitted by February 15<sup>th</sup> and submit all materials for transfer by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Students entering Spring semester must be admitted by October 1<sup>st</sup> and submit all materials for transfer by November 1<sup>st</sup>.

\*\*MCAD will accept up to 6 credits of non-English language courses (e.g. German, Japanese, Spanish, etc).
