

MINNESOTA STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

Concordia University, St. Paul

AND

Dakota County Technical College

This Agreement is entered into between **Concordia University, St. Paul**
and **Dakota County Technical College**

This Agreement and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the laws of the State of Minnesota.

Concordia University, St. Paul has established a **BA, Information Technology Management (cohort)**, and **Dakota County Technical College** has established an **AAS, Software Development** and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another.

The Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities is authorized by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 136F to enter into Agreements and has delegated this authority to colleges and universities.

It is mutually agreed upon:

Admission and Graduation Requirements

- A. Concordia University, St. Paul admission and program admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and to students who transfer under this agreement.
- B. Students accepted into the Concordia University, St. Paul must fulfill the 128 credits graduation requirements.

Transfer of Credits

- A. Concordia University, St. Paul will accept (up to 71 credits; 17 General Education and 54 from the major) from **Dakota County Technical College , AAS, Software Development** to apply to **BA, Information Technology Management (cohort)** [33 credits; and remaining General Education requirements] remain to complete the receiving program and award. Concordia University students need 128 credits to graduate.
- B. Courses will transfer as described in the Program Articulation Table included in this Articulation Agreement.

Terms of Agreement

- A. The Chief Academic Officers or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
- B. Program curriculum and requirements listed in the Program Articulation Table may change.
- C. This Articulation Agreement is effective on 08/06/2009 and shall remain in effect until 08/06/2014 unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
- D. This Articulation Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning on or after 08/06/2014.

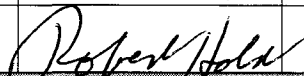

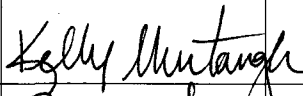
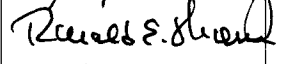
