

TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

For the
B.S. in Management

Developed in response to place-bound professionals' need for additional education, the Bachelor of Science degree in Management is a collaborative effort between Century College and the University of Wisconsin-Stout.

The 120 credit degree has a 40 credit General Education requirement, 40 credits of Major Studies and 40 credits in the Technical Emphasis area. The 40 credit block of courses in the Technical Emphasis area for the Management major requires the development of competence in a technical area. For purposes of transfer between Century College and UW-Stout, a technical area is recognized as any of the areas for which Century College offer either an A.S., A.A.S., or two-year diploma program.

UW-Stout recognizes that the successful completion of the program at Century College is sufficient evidence to warrant our acceptance of technical credits in this area towards the B.S. in Management.

General Education courses offered as a part of the A.A.S. program at Century College in the general education areas (Minnesota Transfer Curriculum) will transfer and be used towards the general education requirements for the B.S. in Management. These courses will meet similar general education areas at UW-Stout as they do Goal areas for MnSCU schools.

Minnesota State Colleges and Universities Board Policy as defined in Chapter 3 Educational Policies; 17 Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates, Subpart C identifies that "An AS program shall include a minimum of 30 semester credits in general education credits." In Chapter 3 Educational Policies; 17 Degrees, Diplomas and Certificates, Subpart D identifies that "An AAS program shall include a minimum of 25 percent of the total semester credits in general education credits." Based on this information, UW-Stout recommends some or all of the following general education area credits to be taken:

Composition

Speech

History/Social Science (General or Macro Economics Recommended)

College Algebra and/or Statistics

Natural Science (minimum 4 credits) which includes a lab

**additional courses in the History/Social Science area and/or in the Humanities/Fine*

Arts area may be taken for students in an AS program


The following limitations apply for the B.S. in Management:

1. Each student must satisfy the ethnic studies and global perspective requirements for graduation.
2. To fill the minimum residence requirement, each student must earn 32 semester hours of credit in residence through UW-Stout. By completing the Major Studies portion of this degree, the students will satisfy this requirement.
3. The attached program plan sheet reflects the requirements in the Management program which pertains to this agreement. Please note identified specific general education courses required for this program.
4. Total credits required for completing a degree in Management at UW-Stout include:

5. This articulation agreement applies only to the B.S. in Management in effect 2008 Spring semester until revised. A change of major invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved within some other program-to-program articulation agreement for a different major at UW-Stout.
6. Students may be in the process of completing their A.A.S or A.S. degree with Century College at the time they begin their B.S. in Management.
